

them will be charged for a replacement)

Board: Meals will be granted by the organizer in the

competition centre. Breakfast, lunch packet and supper will be provided on Saturday, and breakfast

and dinner on Sunday.

Breakfast: 60,- CZK/person

cheese, salami, butter, jam, 3 pieces of rolls or bread porridge (gruel or semolina)

Lunch packet: 60,- CZK/person

3 pieces of rolls or bread, fruits,

salami, cheese, pate, waffle

Supper: 60,- CZK/person

soup, chicken fillet, rice

Dinner: 60,- CZK/person

soup, pork schnitzel, potatoes

Accommodation: Basic school in Dubá

Sleeping in the building of basic school, on the floor of gym hall or classrooms. We recommend you to bring your own air-beds or similar equipment.

Fee: 65,- CZK/person/1 night

Showers with warm water are available in the building.

(or in surrounding streets according to traffic signs)

Further information: Competitors are starting on their own risk. Your own medical check-up is recommended; each competitor is responsible for his/her health (or his/her legitimate representative in the case of youngsters under 18). All participants, who are members of Czech ARDF Association, are covered by collective policy.

The organizer retains the right to change of some information within the scope of ARDF rules; the changes will be announced at the competition website.

Warning:

Please keep in your mind that the competition takes place in the protected landscape area. Smaller areas with high protection level are marked in maps by purple crosshatch; it is strongly forbidden to enter these areas (optimal course routes are not going through them). Violation of this restriction will be penalized by disqualification. (Apart from the fact of bad reputation of ARDF in such case...)

Using of spikes (spike shoes) is prohibited in sandstone area!

Surroundings:

Kokořínsko offers very attractive localities for your trips. Besides beautiful and interesting rock formations, there are also wetlands with a lot of nice and rare plant species. Please use only tourist paths in any case.

In the neighbourhood you can find also historical sights; the most famous are castles Kokořín, Houska and Starý Berštejn, or the ruins of Jestřebí castle with free entrance. After the races, you have an ideal possibility to visit these places.




Transport:

There is simple way **by bus** line Praha-Česká Lípa; the basic school is situated near the bus station. There is no possibility to arrive **by train**; the probable reason is that no track comes through the town of Dubá. :o) May be the most simple way is **by car**, Dubá is located on the road no. 9 between Mělník and Česká Lípa; please take care that there are lot of turnings and this road is densely used as "racing course" of motorcyclists. You

can also use the eastern direction, using motorway R10 (E65), near Mladá Boleslav turn to road no. 38 and in Doksy turn left to road no. 270. (We hope that all is well marked).


